Health and Safety Policy

- Involve the senior management team in health and safety communication and improvement activities, including regular updates;
- Encourage our suppliers to commit to similar principles in relation to health and safety work practices and activities;
- Review the effectiveness of health and safety management, including this policy;
- Provide periodic reports on progress in tackling health and safety matters.
